Healthy Eating Programme

The Food Dudes Healthy Eating Programme is back and will run in the school for the next few weeks. Food Dudes is a programme developed by the University of Wales, Bangor, to encourage children to eat more fruit and vegetables both in school and at home. Pupils are encouraged to try out different fruits and vegetables which are delivered free of charge to the school each morning. The programme in Ireland received a "counteracting obesity" award from the World Health Organisation (WHO) in 2006. The programme is managed by Bord Bia and to date over 3,100 primary schools have participated. Funding has been made available by the



Department of Agriculture, Food and the Marine and the EU School Fruit Scheme for schools.
