CHILD PROTECTION



The [Child Protection Procedures for Schools 2025](#) build on the previous Child Protection Procedures for Primary and Post-Primary Schools and take account of the statutory obligations under the Children First Act, 2015 and the Children First: National Guidance for the Protection and Welfare of Children 2017.

These procedures set out requirements to ensure that reporting procedures in line with Children First are in place and that school personnel know how to recognise and report alleged child protection concerns, and that parents/guardians and all school personnel are aware of the school's child protection and safeguarding procedures.
