#### Community Playground Now Open

It's great to see that the Termonfeckin Community Playground is now open and it will be a wonderful amenity for all of the children in the local area for many years to come. The pupils in Senior Infants and in both 5<sup>th</sup> Classes have been working with artist, Breda Marron, to help design some artwork which will be installed in the playground. We are really looking forward to seeing that when it's completed.

Since the playground opened, a significant number of pupils go into it each morning instead of coming into the school grounds. These pupils then come into the school yard when they hear the "lining up" bell at 9.15am. I've explained to the children that they need to check with their parents that they are allowed to go to the playground before they come into school in the morning. I've also explained that pupils need to be in the school yard by 9.15am so that the class lines can be formed.

Parents should be aware that while supervision is provided by teachers and SNAs in the school yard from 9.05am to 9.20am each morning, there is <u>no supervision in the community playground</u> as it's outside the school grounds.
